## **Key-Takeaway**

- One tool that combines various aspects, circularity, certification, availability, location, volume
- Innovative aspect of self-assessment
- Benefitial for biomass providers
- Enhanced transparency, increases trust and credibility
- Automation potential
- Digital Product Passport
- Based on improved certification frameworks
- Covers full chain of custody



## **Key-Takeaway**

- No validation of added data
- Complexity of CO2-footprint calculation not implemented
- No certification recommendation to proceed
- No clear process of allocation of by products to main-products
- No granted harmonization with existing labels and certification schemes
